MDT proposes a resurfacing project for Secondary Highway 269 near Corvallis, MT in Ravalli County

Corvallis - The Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) would like to notify the public and seek comments on a proposal to resurface about 3.7 miles of Highway 269 in Ravalli County. The project begins north of the Popham Lane intersection about 2.8 miles north of Corvallis, at reference post 8.5 and extends north for 3.7 miles ending about 1.0 miles south of the Victor Crossing intersection at reference post 12.2.

Proposed work includes microsurfacing, bridge deck crack sealing, upgraded pavement marking, and signage.

The purpose of the project is to extend the service life of the highway and take cost-effective action to preserve and maintain the existing highway.

The public can expect single-lane closures in the project area during working hours. More information regarding closures will be made available prior to the beginning of construction.

No property acquisition or utility relocations are anticipated for this project.

Construction is expected to begin in 2014, depending on availability of funding and completion of design.
