Ravalli County Commissioners:

I am a resident of Florence, MT, and chief election judge for Precinct 24. In response to the Coronavirus pandemic, our voting site, the Florence Carlton School, will not be available for our use. Under the draft re-opening plan for the school, no non-school uses will be allowed on site. Additionally, the specific location of our regular voting activity, the new gym, will be used as the lunch room for elementary students.

Precincts 23 and 24 hold their regular elections at this site.

We don't know what the final plan for school re-opening will be. We can only make decisions based on information currently available. Regular elections are not possible based on what we know now.

During the primary elections, we were able to safely provide a drop box for the voters. For the November election, the Election Administrator also plans to make available absentee voter ballots for any voters who need one. Every single absentee voter is required to sign their ballot envelope attesting to their right to vote, and every single signature is validated with the voters' registration information at the Clerk and Recorder's office.

Voter fraud is not possible in Ravalli County.

Please support vote by mail for the November election.
