Montana State Parks (a division of Montana Fish, Wildlife & Parks; FWP) proposes public-access improvements on a newly acquired 0.9-acre property (parcel) immediately south of its Fort Owen State Park (SP), located approximately 1-mile northwest of Stevensville in Ravalli County in Region 2 FWP. The proposed SP project would develop a parking area that would address decades-old challenges for site management, improve public access to this historic site, and reduce trespass for the adjacent private landowner.
