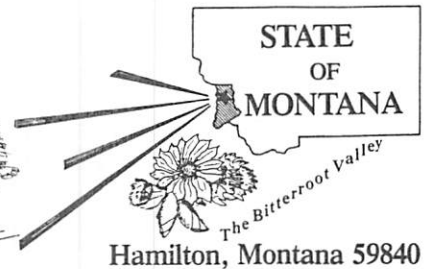

This letter is to confirm that Ravalli County, in applying for the FY20 Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities – Ravalli County Como Dam Multi-hazard Mitigation Project, is fully aware that the project funding will be conducted up to the following maximum amounts as follows:

It is understood the total project cost projection is based upon preliminary estimates and may be subject to change. It is also understood that Ravalli County is prepared to satisfy its match by either cash or well-documented “in kind” contribution. The value of these local contributions may exceed the minimum (25%) match amount requirement but no additional FEMA Federal funds are available.

Ravalli County will collect and provide detailed documentation to verify cash, “in kind” and/or other task match expenditures associated with this project for submission in quarterly reports.
