Standing Together for Freedom

Dear Alan and Terry,

I am writing this letter for and in behalf of Ben Lewis, Heather Jessop, T.C. Richardson and myself. I am aware of and have reviewed recent communication between yourselves and these individuals relative to their resignations from the Board, or more appropriately their positions as managing members for Stand Together for Freedom LLC (the "Organization"). I have reviewed the correspondence, paperwork and organizational papers relating to the Organization. It is my understanding that Mr. Lewis called for an emergency meeting and you both refused to schedule one. That was and is unacceptable, but it is indicative of how you and Terry have conducted yourselves from the very beginning. You have acted as the sole authority on any actions of the Organization and I'm sure you will continue to do so. According to your own Operating Agreement five members are necessary for Organizational action, but it seems, from all indications, that you see the Organization as yourselves. The power in a corporation comes from the Board, the power in an LLC comes from the Managing Members. The President serves at the pleasure and by authority of the Board or Managing Members as the case may be. You have failed to realize that these three individuals could have lawfully removed you from the Organization, but they are not those kind of individuals. It is my hope that you learn how to legally run the Organization in the future. I want to make it clear that the Organization and you, by the conditions of the Operating Agreement will now indemnify Mr. Lewis, Mrs. Jessop and Mr. Richardson from any and all

liability associated with the Organization. In addition, because of the manner in which you have conducted yourselves, you may have incurred tax liability with taxing authorities. Mr. Lewis, Mrs. Jessop and Mr. Richardson are not responsible for any of your acts prior to their resignations and after same. Because you have failed on a number of occasions to keep your fellow managing members informed of your actions, we are requesting a copy of any and all contracts you may have entered into, any claims (real or contingent) that may be pending against you or the Organization, and a final financial report which complies with GAAP in every material aspect. I think it is fair to expect that since you run everything you should be able to provide those items by Tuesday the 9<sup>th</sup> of February at 5:00 pm Mountain Standard Time. In addition, I would caution you concerning your communications with others concerning the resignations. It is appropriate that you make a brief statement that these fine individuals have resigned, nothing more. They will not talk detrimentally about you and you should govern your actions likewise. They are saddened that they have felt it necessary to take this action. I, on the other hand, will rest easier for these good people.

Now, I speak for myself, and myself alone. I believe you are basically good people who are in over your heads. You need help with the Organization. Just because other people are not following the rule of law it does not excuse you to do the same. I wish you well in the future, but do not be mistaken, that when you disregard the rules you do so at great peril to yourselves. I stand behind every single word I
