Dear Commssioners, I am attempting to talk to a county commissioner about the possible grinding of the pavement on Meridian Road in Victor. I live just north of the intersection of Sweathouse road on Meridian Road (2662 Meridian Road). I have spoken to the county road agent (Nate Pelkey). He has informed me that they plan on grinding all the pavement that is presently on Meridian Road. Beginning at Sweathouse Road to turning that part of Meridian Road up to Curlew Mine Road, back to gravel. I have owned the property for 17 years have had gravel and paved road over those years. I spent years paying to have the gravel treated each year. I have not had to pay for that treatment the last few years. I would like to talk to the commissioners about the grinding not being completely done from the intersection of Sweathouse, but instead starting just after the 7th house on the short section of pavement. The beginning spot I am asking for is just north of Howard and Betty Hardiman. The 1/4 mile that I am asking to be left is rough, but it is at least pavement. There are 7 homes on that short section. The other section north of the Hardiman's house is very rough and is actually falling about as the road agent has said. I would ask that the commissioners at least go and look at the section I am talking about to please leave the 1/4 mile from Sweathouse to the Hardiman's house.
