Trail Maintenance Project

Hamilton, MT, June 4 — Bitter Root Back Country Horsemen (BRBCH) and the Bitterroot National Forest are partnering on a trail maintenance project next weekend.

The work will occur Saturday, June 12th at Bass Creek Recreation Area on the Stevensville Ranger District. Volunteers will be doing maintenance on all trails including Fire Ecology, Nature, and Larry Creek. They will also be installing new trail and mile marker signs.

The public should be on alert and watch out for volunteer work crews and stock at these locations.
