Happy October! Next week, construction will continue on the South of Stevensville Safety Improvements project. Travel will be reduced to one lane in two-mile sections between North Birch Creek Road and Pine Hollow Road as crews relocate utilities, install fencing, and conduct pipework on the Eastside Highway, Highway 269.

Work will carry on throughout the month and will likely take place as long as the weather allows. As always, drivers are encouraged to be mindful of changing conditions, reduce their speed, and be alert for workers.
