Subject: [EXTERNAL] South of Stevensville Weekly Update

Good morning,

Next week, Schellinger Construction and the Montana Department of Transportation continue construction on the South of Stevensville Safety Improvements project. As crews continue to move north, traffic patterns should stay similar to prior weeks.

Crews are continuing to install culverts, the piping underneath the roadway that allows for movement of water/debris and acts as a load-bearing structure. Much of this work, and the work to come in the next few weeks, is dependent on the project's partners responsible for utilities. Once the utilities are taken care of, Schellinger's crews will begin the remaining tasks for this project's completion.

Expect one lane of travel in two-mile work zones throughout the week as crews conduct pipe work between North Birch Creek Road and Pine Hollow Road. This will only be taking place during the day, though speeds will continue to be lowered at night. Drivers should continue to practice caution on this stretch of roadway 24-hours a day.

If you are a landowner and need to contact the project team regarding fencing, utilities, or anything else relating to your land, please let me know. We're here to help.

Weekly updates will be provided every Friday throughout construction.
