Hello, my name is Jeff Jessop. I currently am staying at a rental on Jessica Court in Corvallis. In the morning when I leave for work I turn onto Market Street, and then onto Woodside Cutoff Road. I noticed the kids from the neighborhood walking to school. There are roughly 80 homes, 16 town homes and the Court Yard Apartments. Many of these dwellings have kids that walk to school and have to cross Woodside cutoff to get to school. In the morning and after school is when that road is the busiest. After witnessing a car screeching to a halt upon seeing some kids trying to cross that road, I am very concerned for the safety of those kids. I am asking that the county please put a crosswalk either at Market street, or at Main street with flashing lights when being occupied, so these kids can cross Woodside Cutoff safely. I have talked to the Corvallis School District about my concern as well. I appreciate you taking the time to read this email and hope you take the time to look into this safety hazard. Thank you for your willingness to serve as our Commissioners as it is often a thankless job and there is always someone mad at you.
