Happy upcoming Thanksgiving!

The Montana Department of Transportation and Schellinger Construction have wrapped up paving operations and construction activity has finished for the season. Construction crews will return in late winter 2022 (around February), weather permitting, to work on box culverts and other finishing work.

Utility work on the project site will be ongoing throughout the winter with little to no disruption to traffic. Work will pause this week as utility crews celebrate the Thanksgiving holiday and resume on Monday, November 29.

Drivers are once again traveling through the area at 65 mph but should proceed carefully, watch their speed, and be mindful of workers, equipment, and signs.

MDT will inform the public and media of when construction activity will resume on the project before work begins in late winter 2022. Until then, we hope you have a safe and enjoyable holiday season.
