Hello Ravalli County Commissioners,

I am inquiring about how to go about changing the speed limit on a road and who I should contact for this. I have lived at my home on Summerdale Road in Corvallis for 11 years and have been amazed by the posted speed limit. Our road is barely wide enough for two cars to pass, has no center line, many blind hills, a rough crumbling road edge and a lot of people who run, walk, bike, or ride horses along it. The posted speed limit is 45 (which more than just a few people go in extreme excess of). I think a more reasonable speed limit would be 35 which would match Popham Road to the north. Popham is wider, in better condition and has fewer driveways and people recreating.

I understand I likely will need a consensus of my neighbors and am prepared to contact them regarding a possible speed limit change.
