Happy March!

This week, the Montana Department of Transportation (MDT) and Schellinger Construction will continue work on the Stevensville Safety Improvements project. Please keep in mind that as daylight savings time approaches on Sunday, March 13, crews will continue to work the same hours, Monday through Friday from approximately 7:30 a.m. to 6:30 p.m.

Two pilot zones will be utilized throughout the project area during work hours next week—one on the north end of the project and one on the south. These zones will likely result in some minor delays, so please plan travels accordingly. We will continue to safely guide traffic through the work zone as efficiently as possible.

While crews continue to replace irrigation lines and stabilize banks, drivers are encouraged to be mindful of changing conditions, reduce their speed, and be alert for workers throughout the project area.
