Dear Commissioner Burrows:

I feel it is absolutely essential that we have election integrity in our County. I feel the way to achieve this is as follows:

- 1) No mail-in ballots. Exceptions might be made for those temporarily out of the country, or bed-ridden, hospitalized individuals, of sound mind.
- 2) In person voting, with picture Government ID. No exceptions, except as above, re: in-person voting. GOVERNMENT PICTURE ID SHOULD BE A MANDATORY REQUIREMENT TO VOTE.
- 3) Ballots will be counted by hand, not tabulated by machines.
- 4) Counting will be supervised by members of the public, chosen at random as if for Jury duty. They will be sworn to honesty and integrity. Counting will not be supervised by Government officials.
- 5) Complete transparency in the process.
- 6) Any irregularities will be swiftly and thoroughly investigated and dealt with.

This is the only way we can be guaranteed honest elections. Mail-in ballots leave too much room for fraud and corruption and have no place in elections, other than noted in #1.

I hope you will take these concerns into consideration. Thank you.
