Dear Ravalli County Commissioners,

My house of three, Ravalli County, tax paying citizens oppose the unpaving of Joshua Way.

Joshua Way is .24 miles of road and has 17 plus residence with families who utilize this road daily. This short amount of road seems highly unlikely to make much of budgetary difference or concern.

Our road has two SMALL pot holes at the Cul de Sac end. Something the residence can easily pay for and fix ourselves. To unpave a road this short and whose condition is still great seems to be a waste of money and effort.

The unpaving of this road lessens home values, creates unwanted dust even with mitigation, and won't even allow a baby stroller to be pushed. There is no sidewalks for our residence to use.

A unmaintained paved road is still better then a dirt road, plain and simple.
