Mr. & Mrs. Graham,

On July 30th you applied a very dangerous, hazardous, corrosive chemical to the public road of Snowy Mountain View Road surface in front of your house (3424) with no regard to the harmful adverse effects to the environment, safety of the people travelling on the road, wildlife, pets and animals, water runoff, etc. After our conversation on Monday August 1st you told me you would not do it again. The following day Tuesday August 2nd you called and told me you had magnesium chloride applied to the road.

What you applied to the road should be professionally mitigated to remove the hazard and danger to the environment and people travelling on the road. Please have this done as quickly as possible to avoid any further damage to the environment and for the safety of the community and people travelling on the road. In talking with the county, state, and other environmental agencies the quickest most effective way to mitigate the scenario you created would be to have 2" of gravel put down on top of the dangerous, hazardous, corrosive chemical you already applied to somewhat negate its harmful effects. Please do this at once and advise when it is complete and safe to travel on the road again.
