We urgently request that you review the plans and inspect Daly Ave. from Marcus St. to Golf Course Rd. for resurfacing since it is causing a safety and traffic hazard for children, adults and emergency personnel due to the large potholes, frost bubbles and deterioration of the road edges. We understand that the schedule allows for this to be done sometime in 5 years! Please reconsider the safety and traffic priorities for the need to schedule completion of the resurfacing before school starts in the fall. We live on South Sapphire St., which has its own ever enlarging potholes and frost bubbles, and travel on Daly Ave. every day, trying hard to avoid the very deep potholes and the swerving traffic. It is definitely a hazard.
