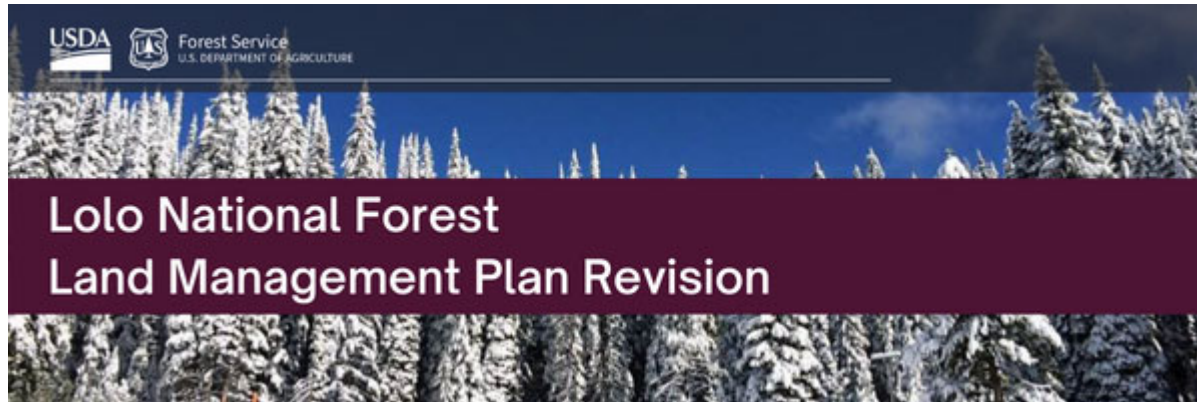

Hello and Happy New Year from the Lolo Plan Revision Team!

I am pleased to be writing you to kick off public engagement in earnest for the Lolo Plan Revision. We are beginning engagement in anticipation of a Notice of Initiation of the Revision process to be published in the coming months. The first milestone we hope to work with you on is a draft Assessment this spring!

Our [Web Hub](#) has been updated with an array of information. Based on your input, we have updated the [Public Engagement and Participation Strategy \(PEPS\)](#). The Web Hub also hosts a new welcome video and a “Meeting in a Box” feature with a library of frequently asked questions, our [first periodic newsletter](#), and other useful information. Finally, you will find a detailed calendar of engagement events. You’ll see a variety of formats offered, including:

1. **Webinars** are online presentations to help you prepare for workshops and comment periods. This format will include the opportunity for questions and answers but is not designed to gather input. Presentations will be recorded and posted to the Web Hub so you can view them at any time. We will also present relevant material prior to in-person workshops.
2. **Workshops** will be held in person with a virtual connection option to build shared knowledge on specific topics. Workshops will be interactive sessions that create a collaborative culture across participants and foster information exchange.
3. **Ranger Chats** are informal face-to-face opportunities for dialogue hosted by the District Rangers once a month at their offices.
4. **Revision Team Office Hours** are informal virtual opportunities for dialogue directly with the revision team available monthly.
