L. J. Werth, certifies that he has caused to be surveyed, subdivided and platted in lots and avenues as shown by this plat and survey hereunto annexed the following tract of land, to-wit:

Beginning at a point that is 20 feet east and 367 feet south of the northwest corner of NE $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 31, Township 6 North, Range 20 West, P.M.M. thence from said point of beginning south 903.7 feet; thence east 482 feet; thence north 903.7 feet; thence west 482 feet to place of beginning, 10 acres, more or less, RESERVING therefrom 20 feet along west side for the existing road and 20 feet along south side for a ditch, the above described tract being southwest part of Lot 16, Block 2, Daly Acres, Ravalli County, Montana, according to recorded plat thereof, to be known and designated as Werth Addition No. 3 and the land included in all avenues and roads shown on said plat are granted and dedicated to use of the public forever.
