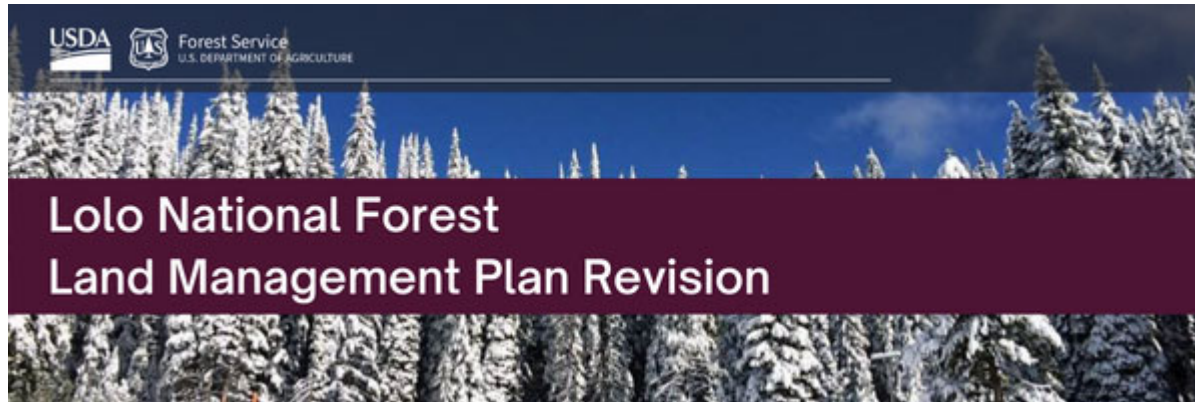

Greetings!

March is upon us, and we have another packed month for the Lolo Plan Revision! The team continues to work on compiling a draft assessment that encompasses the array of important resources and interests on the Lolo National Forest. We also anticipate that within the next month, our Notice of Intent to prepare an assessment and initiate the plan revision process will be published in the Federal Register.

I have heard questions about how the input we gather during engagement events is documented and used. We summarize and review all information to shape our work. The assessment phase is a period of inviting information submission relevant to the existing conditions, status, and trends on the Lolo National Forest. In addition to participating in engagements, you may use our email address to share information. Our first formal comment opportunities will be coming up later this spring!
