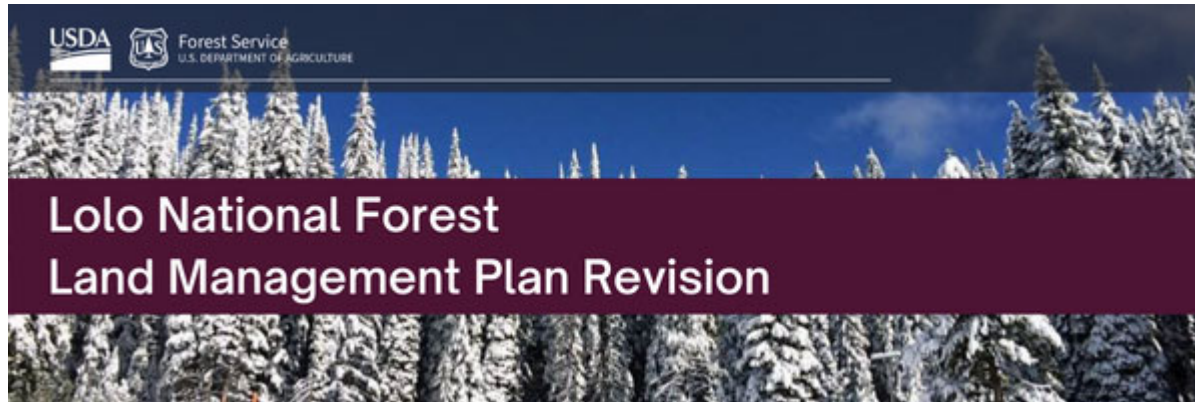

This month we will be embarking on wilderness inventory workshops in preparation for the first comment period of the revision process. The upcoming comment period is intended to gather input on both the draft wild and scenic rivers inventory and outstanding remarkable value evaluation framework as well as the draft wilderness inventory. We anticipate this comment period to run from **Monday, April 17th through Monday, May 1st**. When the comment period opens, on the Web Hub you will find a link to the CARA online comment submission form as well as a Talking Points Collaborative Mapping tool where you may enter comments spatially.
