I am pleased to announce that the comment period on the draft wild and scenic rivers inventory, draft outstanding remarkable value evaluation framework, and draft wilderness inventory for the Lolo Plan Revision is now open for the next 30 days (**April 17<sup>th</sup> through May 16<sup>th</sup>**). There, you'll find quick links to review materials; these materials are the same ones you have seen on the Wilderness and Wild and Scenic pages. While we wait for your comments, our team continues to work on compiling the draft assessment. As per our planning handbook, the next step for the wild and scenic rivers and wilderness processes – evaluation - will begin after this assessment is complete. We plan to host engagements to gather your input on the evaluations in the summer and fall. You will then have an opportunity to formally comment on the inventories and evaluations as part of the proposed action and, later, in the draft environmental impact statement. The inventories and evaluations are not final until the decision on the revised plan is made – so you have many more chances to help us refine this important work.

In the meantime, I look forward to reaching out to you again soon regarding the engagement activities that May will bring. You can look forward to several more webinars in preparation of our next commenting milestone: the draft assessment!
