I have been advised by Joan Redeen, Executive Assistant - Communications, District 1 Missoula, Montana Department of Transportation, to contact you about our concerns of traffic on Hwy 93 Stevensville light to mile marker 66.

We are asking to have the following items listed below to be referred to MDT for consideration after July 1, 2023 which is the end date of public comment..

1. Reduce speed to 45 mph Stevensville light to mile marker 66.
2. Have an excessive noise study done using the noise process within the MDT project flow chart. This may provide solutions to our concerns in this area, Stevensville light to mile marker 66.
3. Reconfigure Stevensville light intersection to include left turn lanes on the eastside and westside of the intersection. The need for striping is essential. The westside has not been done for years.
4. Remove concrete island located at the intersection of Hwy 93 and south Kootenai Road. The north island impedes access to Hwy 93 and serves no other purpose than being a hazard.
