I am writing to you on behalf of Evergreen Chamber of Commerce in Evergreen (Kalispell) MT. The Evergreen Hwy 2 and Hwy 35 corridor encompasses approximately 3 miles of frontage. Evergreen has been inundated with Marijuana Dispensaries. We believe the count to be over 30 and growing. That makes the density equal to a dispensary, stunningly, every 540'. In fact, the county is now disparagingly referring to our Evergreen business district as "the Green Mile"

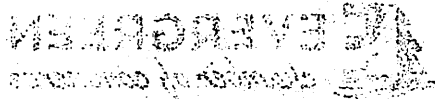
