The Lost Horse fire has not grown in several days and remains at 59 acres. Due to very limited fire activity, many of the resources have been released to assist with other fires in the area, including on the Lolo National Forest. We will continue to monitor the Lost Horse fire daily from the air and with road patrols and if fire activity picks up, will respond with additional resources.
