Commissioners, Clerks and Treasurers,

I wanted to follow up to make sure you realize that the dollar amount for your county has to be reduced by 7.3% because PILT is an appropriation and is subject to sequestration. The table we sent out from the USFS just applies the sequestration to the state total not each county. With the sequestration taken off, the total payments to counties in Montana will be \$2,206,370, less than 10% of last year's PILT payments of \$28,809,242.

The latest I have heard is that the US Senate will take up the Keystone Pipeline bill again today after failing to pass it earlier this week because Senate Leadership would not consider amendments. There are well over 100 proposed amendments that may be considered today so they may be in for a long day. Full funding for PILT is among the proposed amendments.
