Weekend Trail Project

Hamilton, Montana (May 27, 2015) – Bitter Root Back Country Horsemen (BRBCH) and the Bitterroot National Forest are partnering on a trail improvement project on the Stevensville Ranger District. The project is scheduled for this Saturday, May 30th at Larry Creek in the Bass Creek Recreation Area.

The group, along with local area cub scouts will do general trail maintenance including clearing blow down and cleaning water bars and ditches on all trails including the fire ecology and nature trail. Besides clearing trails the group will also be installing new signs. The public should be on alert and watch out for volunteer work crews and stock on these trails.
