Thank you for your response....telephone service at times will not allow the recorder to work...sorry missed your call/message.
Some months ago when your Dept. was planning for road improvements, I left message for a couple of the county commissioners advising that though the road surface on Sleeping Child was in good shape and your road crews always did a great job during snow times, etc., any previous pavement shoulder/centerline road markings were nearly, if not completely gone on the entire road length and asked if possible to also consider painting new markings on our road. I was advised it would be discussed. Today, coming back from town, I was very pleasantly surprised to see new shoulder/center & no passing striping. The striping crew was finishing up near the Old Darby road and I thanked them for their work. They said they only knew about striping this far and not certain about any further striping.
