To the Commissioners:

At first blush, the idea of building a racetrack for motor sports does not seem like good idea from the standpoint of the fairgrounds being a good neighbor. I live in the south end of Hamilton, so I do not live next to the fairgrounds. The people that do live near the fairgrounds have a legitimate issue with the proposal. I think it is the responsibility of the Fair Board and proponents of the proposal to put in the time and money to illustrate that the track won't be a nuisance to the neighbors.

I looked online and saw that noise studies can be done to learn what affect the activities will have on the neighborhood. I suggest that if the Fair Board wants to be a good neighbor, they should fund a professional study to assess the noise level of the proposed facility. I would also suggest that the Commissioners oversee the study so that an "impartial" finding will be the result.
