Some time ago a petition was submitted to the Board of County Commissioners requesting consideration of paving Daly Ave. What got paved was Hattie St.

My memory is that we petitioners asked for a public meeting with the BCC to discuss the possibility of re-conditioning Daly Ave. I would like to request such a meeting be scheduled.

Attached are two photos which illustrate a significant issue with safety on Daly. When the road is busy with vehicles and the sidewalk with pedestrians, north-bound bicyclists have to ride in the narrow space adjacent to the curbs atop the road from Daly School to Marcus St. Winter sanding leaves a deposit of sand against the concrete curbs, chunks of asphalt accumulate in this space, pot holes develop from frequent standing water there; all hazards to a bike's narrow tire width.

Is there a list of the county road department's planned paving projects? Is it possible Daly Ave is on that list for treatment in the near future?
