Dear Commissioner Burrows,

You are correct concerning the Tribunal. The trial isn't over yet either, so the outcome of that remains to be determined.

The so called Poison Papers found stored in the Oregon barn is what is important. They show documented (in writing in thousands of pages) collusion between the chemical companies, the false testing laboratories and the EPA to register untested or improperly tested products for use, no matter what they do to people, especially newborns or to other animals, again especially newborns. Right after the birth defects began on the animals (including human newborns) in spring of 1995, Montana went from rating near the bottom into the top 20 states with the highest cancer rate per capita. In 2003, Montana was the only western state in the top 20, at number 17. By 2013, Montana was number two in cancer deaths of all the western states, exceeded only by the state of Washington. That is not my data, that is the CDC data. Why is all the cancer suddenly occurring in the last 20 years in Montana?

Yesterday, a mother and the little boy who found the bird brought me a fledgling Cowbird that can't walk because of a birth defect in the leg.

I have gotten several hatchlings this year with developmental defects, including 4 starlings, a hatchling American Goldfinch, two House Sparrows and several others. The most often affected hatchlings are from nests near sprayed lawns. This is very concerning, because only a few of the malformed birds are ever actually found and observed by people. (It is also concerning because children play on sprayed lawns.) Most malformed young birds die or are killed by cats or other predators. This is resulting in a fairly significant and observable decline in some of our common birds. (With regard to affected children, the cost of health care keeps going through the roof because of so much needed

care.) One of the Osprey chicks on the nest built on the crane here in the Bitterroot has developmental malformations of the feathers and overall failure to grow to normal size/dwarfism. It has a live camera on it and people all over the world are watching the stunted chick and worrying about it.
