## Information Update

Wednesday September 13, 2017

**Summary:** Fire was active on the west side of the fire, in Brushy Creek, the South Fork of Lolo Creek and on the east side in Sweeney Creek as the fire worked through pockets of unburned fuel. Gusty winds pushed the fire from the South Fork of Lolo Creek to the top of

the ridge above Bass Lake. Crews on the west side contained two spot fires and held the perimeter. Crews continued suppression repair work on the Highway 12 corridor and into the Highway 93 corridor. Firefighters patrolled and mopped up the east side of the fire.

**Today:** With the continued warm, dry weather, fuels are critically dry. Active fire behavior is expected within the interior of the fire creating visible smoke columns this afternoon. Helicopters will be dropping water and retardant on the southwest part of the fire, concentrating on the South Fork of Lolo Creek and north of Bass Lake. Suppression repair crews will be working along Highway 12 and continue south along the Highway 93 corridor. Along the southeast edge of the fire, minimal burn out operations may take place as necessary to manage the intensity of the fire as it progresses south.
