## Information Update

September 18, 2017

**Summary:** With warming and drying conditions, the fire was more active within the interior, including portions of One Horse Creek, Sweeney Creek, and Larry Creek. Mop up continued on the west side of the fire. Suppression repair progressed along Highway 12

and south of Lolo along Highway 93. Hand crews completed the remaining portion of hand line in Larry Creek, wrapping into the Sweeney Creek drainage.

**Today:** Reduced fire activity is expected with moisture moving into the area. Mop up and patrols will continue along the west side of the fire in Brushy Creek and along the 373 Road. Suppression repair will continue with seeding of disturbed areas along Highway 12, as well as road grading and repair of dozer lines along Highway 93. Hand crews will mop up and work to secure hand line in the Larry Creek drainage. Mike Almas' Northern Rockies Team has arrived and will transition with Turman's team today.
