This is the link to a document that was sent to me by a top-level scientist who lives in Eastern U.S. The photos this veterinarian took of cattle and sheep livers and kidneys are interesting. The livers aren't as bad as some of the livers I have photographed on ruminant species here in Ravalli County. I was not familiar with how damaged kidneys look. I did not identify many animals with kidney damage, but lots with liver damage.
