To all interested parties – the Darby Ranger District of the Bitterroot National Forest has released a Proposed Action for the upper Rye and Sleeping Child Creek area, focusing on the acquired lands formerly owned by the Darby Lumber Company, but also including all adjacent National Forest land. The Darby Lumber Lands Watershed Improvement and Travel Management Project has travel management, restoration, and aspen promotion activities that are detailed in the attached letter.
