
Thank you for contacting me about the Protecting Honest Fishermen Act (H.R. 3108). I appreciate your concerns.

This bill would require additional labeling for commercially marketed seafood, including the scientific name of the seafood species, whether or not the fish was farm raised, and the date of the catch. This bill is currently before the House Committee on Ways and Means.

As a farmer, I believe that consumers have a right to know what's in their food and how their food is made. That's why I have repeatedly supported the labeling of genetically modified foods, so that folks know what they're putting on their dining room tables.
