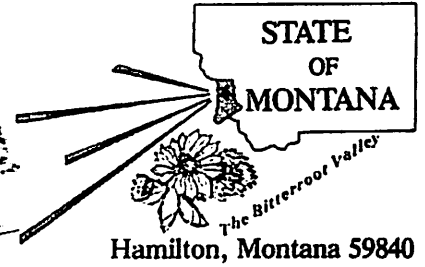
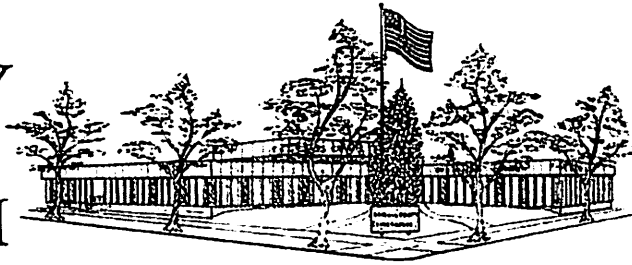

I hope this letter reaches you in the best of spirits. I write this with the utmost respect in regards to the County Commissioners office understanding some of the duties and services that are provided to this Great Community on behalf of the Commission. With this being said, the intent of this letter is to obtain either donations and or funding directed toward Bayall County Detention Center. Please understand this is just a general request, keeping three pertinent ideas in mind: peoples religious beliefs, Health and Welfare, and a very important one is Education. It is my belief that if we simply start with maintaining and providing materials in regard to these three very important matters to our Detention Centers and/or Jail facilities allowing offenders an extremely important opportunity to heal there mind, body and soul while furthering there Education in Return Raising the possibility of them to Not Re-offend instead be a productive member of our Great Community. I would like to make three very inexpensive Recommendation in hopes of Achieving a Solution to this problem.


First and Foremost I would like to address the lack of Religious materials, trying to keep an open mind and complete respect to each and every individual's Religious beliefs. It has been brought to my Attention Upon Request of either the book of Mormon, i.e. LDS Services, or Catholic Services, Unfortunately Navarre County is unable to provide these materials. I honestly believe if we were able to reach out to select Churches they would be able to donate a limited supply to those who would like to request it.

Second allowing offenders to alliviate stress and tention built up by excersizing regularly is by all means an amazing way to prevent conflict between inmates and Detention Center Staff alike. Unfortunately with the very limited space and absolutely no Exercise Equipment available to use, inmates tend to use either our legal material or library books to workout with. In return not Acknowledging the damage they may be causing to them. Handling this matter I would Respectfully ask that we consider obtaining a very minuscule amount of Funding to provide a stationary piece

of equipment that is to include a 3-in-1 workout routine pull-ups, sit-ups, and dips. This very efficient piece of equipment could be a permanent addition to the Ravalli County Detention Center. Helping individuals effected by addiction of drug or Alcohol abuse to heal and recover thier bodies looking forward to a healthier future.

Last but not least and I believe above all is the most important would be pretaining to any and all forms of Educational materials, To include any self help books that could benefit anyone dealing or trying to understand Anger, Addiction, Mental disorders etc. etc. Also Educational books one could study in hopes of furthering thier education i.e. GED Study Guides, Math, Science, etc. in Return maybe peak ones interest to obtain a college degree. Statistics Clearly show by educating ones-self raises the bar for offenders not to place our communities at Risk and or re-offending. An efficient Solution to this problem im not entirely sure of but i think if we sought donations from the public Schools and mabey public library we can Achieve Said goal in a very inexpensive manner. As briefly Stated in the previous letter I sent to the County Commission with all do Respect I ask that

we take the time to consider addressing these matters and situations with a reasonable amount of urgency. And in doing so prepare people that choose to break our laws an opportunity to understand not just why or how they got thierselfs into the situation but there is a way to become a very productive member of the community and in return never come back here. Again thank you for your Time and Consideration in handling these matters.


